

Guidelines for the fulfillment of BGC 515. Seminar Series

15. Seminar Series

All students are encouraged to attend the rich program of lectures, symposia, seminars, performances, lunches, and talks organized by Bard Graduate Center's Public Humanities + Research department. We regard these events as an essential part of our MA program and important to academic formation. For this course, required for completion of the MA degree, students will attend at least ten events during their two years of study (for full-time students) and complete the 515 form which includes a list of events attended and short (c. 300 words) reflection on the experience. 1 credit (MA only).

Fulfilment details:

- Students may attend Wednesday night events, Tuesday lunches, symposia, and/or exhibition tours.
- Only events held at, or sponsored by, Bard Graduate Center count towards this requirement.

The 515 form should be completed after the student has attended 10 events and should be submitted directly to the Office of Academic Programs for review. It will then be shared with the student's advisor for signature. It may be submitted at any time during the program but must be completed by the end of a student's final semester. For students graduating in May 2023, the form should be submitted no later than Friday, May 3.
