2-MONTH INTERNSHIP - BETWEEN MID MAY - END OF JULY 2024

Internship objectives:

A 17th-century architectural gem designed between 1658 and 1661 for Louis XIV's superintendent of finances, Nicolas Fouquet, the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte today houses a rich collection of furniture and works of art. The internship will aim to introduce the student to the various missions of a heritage conservation officer in a building classified as a Historic Monument and open to the public.

The successful intern will help to **classify the collection of glass plates and the collection of architectural plans dating from the end of the 19th century**. In addition, s/he will may also participate in the **reassembly of a collection of armchairs**. For the past ten years, stocktaking has been a regulatory practice in the French museum world. It allows establishing a scientific and material inventory of a part of Château's collections. It consists of dusting, photographing, studying, and inventorying the works.
